




The Gospel today reminds us how important love is in our lives. Jesus says that to love God and to love one another are the most important things he can ask us to do. To love one another is the best thing we can do in life. There is no end to the love God has for each one of us. When we love each other as God loves us, then we are already becoming the best people that God wants us to be.

### **PRESENTATION OF THE SYMBOLS**

**In our sacred space this morning we have:**

1. A table covered with a Green cloth. The colour green, for hope and life, is used during Ordinary time when we listen to stories of Jesus, his mission and his teachings.
2. A candle – the symbol of Jesus who is the light of the world and who always shines even in the darkness.
3. A Bible – we learn all about Jesus from reading the Bible and we use some of the readings from it at Mass.
4. A prayer card – when we say our prayers we can talk to Jesus and listen to him.
5. Sylvester Bear who is at Mass today representing all the boys and girls who cannot be here
6. A Rosary Beads – The Rosary is a special prayer to Mary, the Mother of Jesus and our mother in Heaven. In October we make a special effort to pray the Rosary. If you want to join in, every evening Mon to Fri in October the Rosary and Night Prayer will be available on the webcam from this church at 8.00pm.
7. A Big Red Heart – we all recognise the red heart as a symbol of love. It is a reminder today of how much God loves each one of us and that he asks us to spread that love to everyone else.
