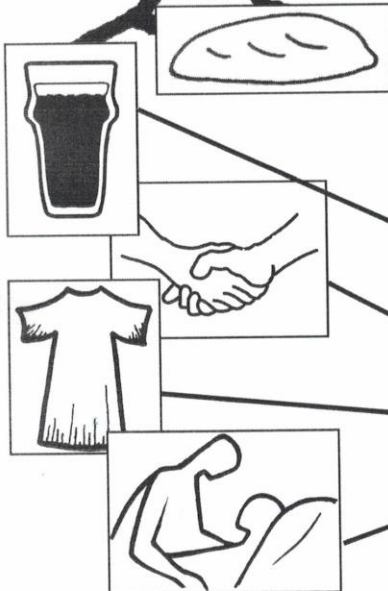

**Good morning and welcome to our Mass.** We welcome all the boys and girls from our local schools of St. Nicholas of Myra, St. Oliver Plunkett School, Scoil Mearnóg, St. Helen's, St. Sylvester's and St. John Paul II, St. Andrew's and Educate Together who are looking in at our Mass this morning with their parents and families.

We also welcome everybody who is watching this Mass on the webcam from Yellow Walls Church here in Malahide.

The first of January is the start of a new year but the school year begins each year in September and the new year in the Church begins in Advent which starts next Sunday. This Sunday then, is the last Sunday of the Church Year and is called the feast of Jesus Christ the King. Today we celebrate Jesus as our King. We are not celebrating Jesus as the King of any country in the world but as the King of our lives. It is most important that all of us should do our best to be good. The greatest example of what is the best way for us to live our lives is to follow the example of Jesus. That is why we call Jesus our King. Jesus is the King of the best way to be good. We know that you all like to be good. It takes a lot of effort. During these days of covid-19 we are asked to make an extra special effort to be good at making sacrifices that help keep us all safe. Jesus, Our King, would say to each of you - 'well done, you are my special friends'

## **PRESENTATION OF THE SYMBOLS**

**In our sacred space this morning we have:**

1. A table covered with a White cloth. The colour white is used on special Feast Days as a symbol of light and joy. Today it stands for the joy we feel at having Jesus as our King.
2. A candle - Symbol of Jesus, the light of the world, who always shines even in the darkness.
3. A Bible - we learn all about Jesus from reading the Bible and we use some of the readings from it at Mass.
4. A prayer card - when we say our prayers we can talk to Jesus and listen to him.
5. Sylvester Bear who is at Mass today representing all the boys and girls who cannot be here with us this morning. Sylvester is wearing his white bow tie as his symbol for today.
6. We present a golden crown - everyone recognises a crown as the sign of a King and even though Jesus is not a king on earth we use this symbol to remind us that he is our King.
7. Finally, we have a shepherd's staff or stick. We will hear in the first reading that Jesus says he will look after us like the shepherd looks after his sheep. This stick reminds us that Jesus is like a caring, loving Good Shepherd.

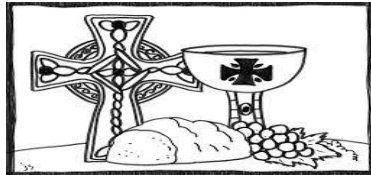
